

## PROJECT WORK OF STUDENTS AS SUMMER/WINTER TRAINING

The National Institute of Biologicals (NIB) was established by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, as an autonomous institution in 1992 with the overall objective to carry out quality control tests of biological products, train personnel and prepare reference standards.



One of the main objectives of the Institute is training technical personnel in laboratory techniques and GLP. Adequate facilities for training and hostel accommodation are available.



*Laboratories for training are equipped with:*

- *Air controlled work stations*
- *Steam sterilisers*
- *Walk-in-cold room*
- *Designed for GLP*

The Institute has been receiving applications for project work as part of M.Sc. degree in Virology, Microbiology, Bio-technology, and Bio-chemistry of 6 months duration. Keeping in view the need for laboratory strengthening, implementation of GLP and to meet the demand from the Universities and requirement of skilled manpower, it is now proposed to start

summer/winter training of 6 months duration from January/July, 2010. Batch of 15 to 20 candidates can be accommodated in each course. The applications for such training courses/project work should be forwarded by the Head of Department or authorized official of the University. Priority will be given to students from Central or State Universities. Students from private institutions will be accommodated if seats are available.



Project work requiring laboratory skills will be assigned. As part of the course, the students will be required to plan, monitor and execute the project and do hands on training under the supervision and guidance of a mentor. Each student will prepare a project report and will be encouraged to write a paper for publication after approval by the Institute. No paper will be published without prior approval.

The selected candidates will be required to pay a sum of Rs. 5000/- to cover the expenses towards course / training support material and consumables. The above fee will be non refundable in the event student not joining the training / project work. Students will be allowed hostel accommodation on request subject to its availability at subsidized charges of Rs.3000/-per room per month on individual or shared basis. Canteen charges will be paid directly by the students.
